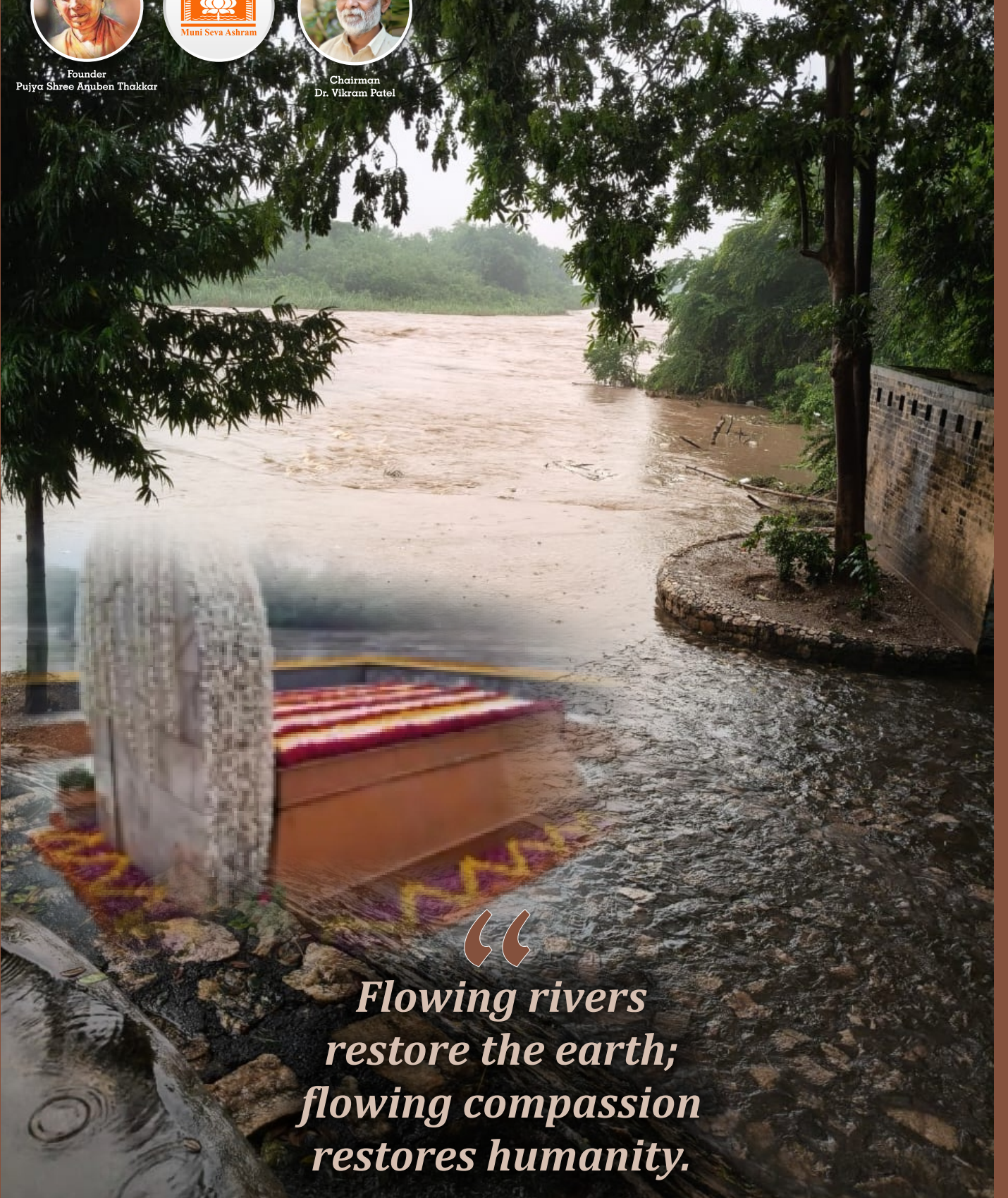

When all seemed lost, destiny led her to Muni Seva Ashram's Vocational Training Centre (VTC) in 2017, where she joined the OT Assistant course. That step marked the beginning of her truly radiant journey.

At VTC, Dipti found not just education but inspiration. With its blend of skill training, life lessons, and the ideals of Pujya Shree Ben, VTC nurtures confidence, courage, and service in young people. Immersed in this atmosphere, she overcame her fears, discovered her voice, and grew into a confident young woman ready to serve.

Her sincerity soon earned her a role as Warden at VTC - not a position of authority for her, but an opportunity to give back. Whether setting up hostels in cities, mobilizing students in remote villages, coordinating with doctors, or even taking on challenging tasks like assisting during the pandemic at Ahmedabad Civil Hospital, she carried out every responsibility with dedication and enthusiasm. Her commitment and leadership eventually saw her entrusted with the role of Operations Manager at VTC, which she fulfills with grace and strength.

Holistic Learning at VTC

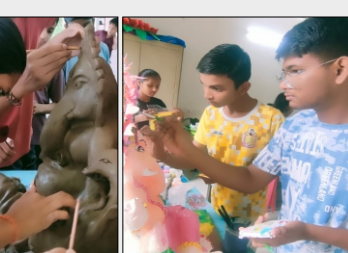
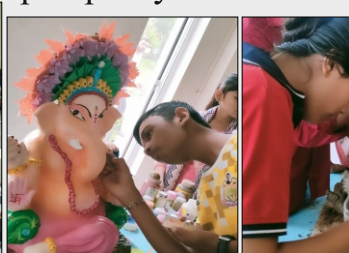

Joining NCC is a journey of **discipline, patriotism, and self-growth**.

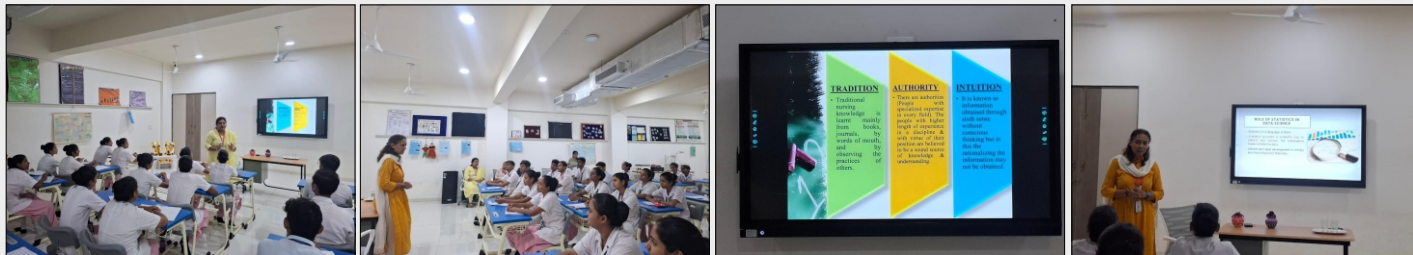


Rainy Day Delights!

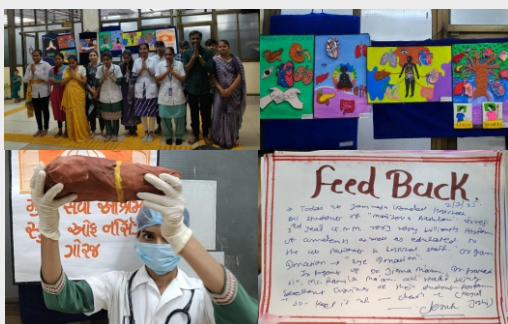


B.Sc. Nursing Students Join Diabetes Care Workshop

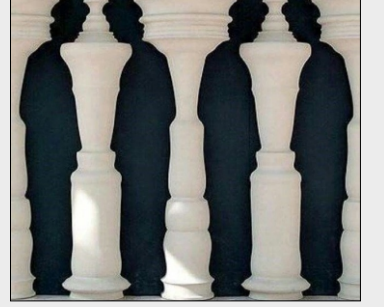
Creating Awareness on Organ Donation



Our 3rd-year GNM students organized a series of awareness programs on organ donation at Jamanabai General Hospital, Vadodara. The initiatives included a rally, pamphlet distribution, poster exhibition, and a skit, all aimed at highlighting the urgent need for organ donation. Through these efforts, the students spread awareness, cleared misconceptions, and inspired society to recognize organ donation as the greatest gift of life.

The warp and weft of any attractive tapestry is the net sum of an interplay between colourful skeins and plaid ones. In the absence of one, the other may attract but cannot hold the attention of the viewer. The same is true of institutions.

Muni Seva Ashram (MSA) has hidden within its pantheon gems who helped consolidate its foundations. Isak Chinwala was fleetingly referred to earlier. He was the epitome of social responsibility. Much before the ashram came into existence, Isak Chinwala had been doing voluntary work in the area. Initially associated with Dr. Gokal Patel, he was amongst the first to commit himself to the ashram. Unassuming and yet a pillar of strength describes him best. One incident comes to mind. The ashram had started a gaushala and the income from the sale of milk

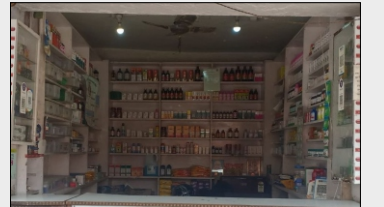


was welcome. Today society is willing to pay premium rates for cow's milk from Gir cows. This was not the case at that time. A number of people found milk from Gir cows expensive and were not willing to buy. On hearing this, Isak Bhai along with his friend Baldi Bhai stepped up and offered to pay more than the rate asked by the ashram saying “ગાય નુ આટલું સારુ દૂધ આટલા ઓછા ભાવે ક્યાં મળે” and the gaushala flourished.

Mahendra Bhai Shah was another of the unsung heroes. He was the principal of the local school and was well connected with the wielders of power. Convinced that the ashram was doing genuinely good work he actively involved himself in furthering the institution. He frequently dined in the humble kitchen of the ashram and reciprocated with greater generosity. Whether it was political or social, all roads were made free from obstruction and red tape.

Just as destiny chose to send Anuben to Goraj, it also chose to send Bihari Kaka there. He was a money lender and also an investor. Underneath the hard facade of his profession was a soft-hearted human being. One day Bihari Kaka and his brother-in-law came to the area to check out a piece of land they were planning to buy. While returning he saw the huts and sheds of the ashram and asked his driver for further information. On hearing that these simple buildings comprised a social service ashram he asked the driver to turn towards it. Anuben welcomed the “Atithi” and offered the simple fare of the kitchen.

Happily accepting the offer, he started enquiring about the ashram. Dr. Vikram Patel, who by that time had joined the ashram, happened to walk in. The conversation veered to the clinic and its organization. Bihari Kaka casually asked where they purchased their medicines. One of the suppliers was Jaishree Medical, who also happened to be known to Bihari Kaka. He asked in passing whether Dr. Vikram could drop in when he next came to Baroda. A few days later Vikram Bhai had to go to buy medicines. Remembering Bihari Kaka's invitation, he dropped in to visit en route to the suppliers. There he was offered a glass of cold water and a cup of hot tea. While sipping tea and making polite conversation, Bihari Kaka casually asked about the monthly expenditure on medicines. It was somewhere around three to four thousand (in the mid-1980s). Without blinking an eyelid came the statement “હવે થી દર મહીને જેટલી દવા નુ બિલ થાય એ મારી પાસે થી લઈ લેજો”



The MSA can never forget these pillars of strength and encouragement. There are others who remain to be thanked which we will take up in coming issues....



On 31st March 2025, Ms. Noopurben Desai, President of Rotary Club of Bombay Pier (RCBP), along with Past President Mr. Suhitbhai Zaveri and friends, visited Muni Seva Ashram. They were accompanied by our Trustee Shri Pradeepbhai Shroff, who has been supporting MSA through Rotary initiatives.

During the visit, MSA highlighted that a large share of Kailash Cancer Hospital and Research

Center's (KCHRC) electricity bill goes toward cooling. To address this, MSA proposed adopting Solar Thermal Air-conditioning. We had successfully run a Scheffler Dish-based system for 15 years, and now plan to install the advanced BIGDISH Concentrator - a system with double efficiency, less space requirement, and a life span of over 25 years.

With CSR support facilitated by RCBP, the project has moved forward. On 3rd September 2025, RCBP transferred an advance of ₹66.3 lakhs to Sunrise CSP India for supply of one BIGDISH unit, expected to be delivered within a month.

This clean-energy system will not only cut down electricity costs but also provide silent, low-maintenance, and eco-friendly cooling for KCHRC, reinforcing MSA's commitment to sustainable healthcare.



We extend our heartfelt gratitude to RCBP and all well-wishers for making this step towards a greener, more compassionate future possible.
