Bhavina beautifully captures the essence of her “Then & Now” experiences, reflecting on the impact EMRS has had on her life.

Language Proficiency	I entered EMRS in the 6th standard, transitioning from a Gujarati-medium school. On my very first day, I was overwhelmed to find the teacher speaking in English. I felt nervous and wanted to go back home.	Thanks to the constant guidance and support of my teachers, I gradually started conversing in English. Today, this skill plays a vital role in my career as a research fellow at Gujarat Biotechnology University.
Morning Routine	Waking up early every morning, regardless of the season, and heading to the garden for running and exercises felt like such a chore. It was difficult to enjoy the routine back then.	Looking back, I realize how this practice instilled discipline and greatly contributed to my physical health today.
Hostel Life	Living in the hostel meant doing everything ourselves, from managing our daily chores to adapting to a fixed menu—eating all kinds of vegetables, even those I didn’t like.	That experience taught me self-reliance and shaped the person I am today.
Extracurricular Activities	I found extracurricular activities quite burdensome alongside academics. Balancing studies and activities felt challenging.	Those very activities gave me the confidence to express myself in front of others. They helped me discover my potential, not just in academics but in sports and other areas as well.



Bhavina concludes her reflections with immense gratitude:

“I feel truly blessed to be a part of EMRS. The school groomed me into a better person, and I will forever remain grateful to my teachers, schoolmates, and everyone who played a role in shaping my journey.”

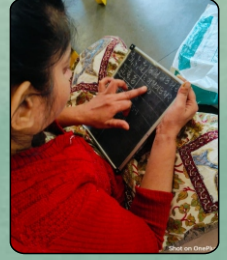
Pujya Shri Anuben envisioned a compassionate world where these daughters are embraced with equality and love, their lives dignified and celebrated as integral to our society's pride.
