At Muni Seva Ashram, childhood blossoms into magic. With love as their foundation and learning as their wings, children are nurtured to soar towards their dreams. Founded by Pujya Shree Anuben in 1978, our 15 crèches are dedicated to transforming the lives of children aged 6 months to 6 years, shaping the future of India with care, education, and health.

Parents, primarily laborers and farmers, can work with peace of mind, knowing their children are cared for from Monday to Saturday, 10 AM to 4:30 PM, receiving nutritious meals and holistic development. These crèches emphasize health, hygiene, nutrition, education, and values through a Montessori-based curriculum, offering regular health check-ups, medication, and comprehensive care.



The impact of the ashram's crèches in these 15 villages has been so profound that, when we received an order to close them as the government planned to take over, local villagers and their representatives rushed to the ashram. They passionately requested that we continue our work, highlighting the invaluable role the crèches play in nurturing their children. This heartfelt support reaffirmed our deep bond with the community, inspiring us to carry on our mission with even greater dedication.

Many of these crèches, which have been serving our communities for over 30 years, are now in need of renovation. Trustee Shree Pradip and Malini Shroff are spearheading efforts to upgrade these vital facilities, committing to renovate seven crèches. The renovation of the Rumipura crèche is already complete, work at Kashipura is currently in progress, and Popdipura is next in line for renovation.

Muni Seva Ashram's educational journey began with Pujya Shri Anuben's balghars or crèches. As the children grew, the need for a primary school arose, leading to the establishment of Sharda Mandir Bakshi Panch Ashram Shala in 1984. This residential, co-educational, Gujarati-medium primary school, recognized by the Gujarat State Education Board, serves 240 tribal students—122 boys and 118 girls—from surrounding villages for class 1st to 8th.



The school provides holistic care alongside quality education, offering nutritious food, hygienic residential facilities, clothing, regular health checks, necessary vaccinations, and medical care when needed.

Co-curricular Activities

This School offers unique cocurricular activities such as Kathak dance, drama, music, farming, agricultural education, and embroidery. The school has four houses—C.V. Raman, Jagdishchandra Bose, APJ Abdul Kalam, and Dr. Vikram Sarabhai—which compete in events like Sulekhan, Mehndi, and the popular "Kaun Banega Gyanpati" program.

Transformative Impact and Expansion at the school

The school's efforts have positively shifted the local community's attitude towards education and hygiene. Parents eagerly enroll their children, leading to brighter futures. Currently, 161 out of 240 students reside on campus. To provide a holistic learning environment for all, a new hostel block is under construction to accommodate 80 more students.

Nestled in the lush green Vankuva campus, Vivekanand Vidhyalaya is a premier Gujarati medium residential higher secondary school for grades 9 to 12. Recognized by GSEB, the school boasts an impressive nearly 99% pass rate for 12th graders. It provides education, boarding, clothing, and medical care to 129 boys and 162 girls, all from tribal communities.



The school offers an additional syllabus teaching scientific farming, animal husbandry, dairy farming, computer courses, and agro processing to support its many students from farming backgrounds.

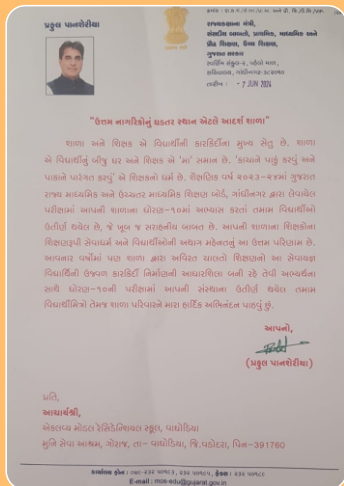
Muni Seva Ashram's commitment to tribal communities led to the creation of the Eklavya Model Residential School, which has since broadened its impact to all aspiring students. Established in 2010, the school operates as an English medium co-ed residential facility under a Public-Private Partnership with the Tribal Development Department of GOG. Serving grades 6 through 12, it follows the GSEB curriculum and currently supports 271 students, including 139 boys and 132 girls, with 253 tribal and 18 non-tribal students.



Holistic education at EMRS is yielding impressive results. From academics to sports fields and artistic stages, our students are continually setting new standards and achieving remarkable success.



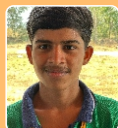
Our school is renowned to produce athletes who perform exceptionally well at state and national level tournaments. In today's Indian scenario, vocational training is crucial as it equips individuals with practical skills, bridging the gap between education and employment. It addresses the growing demand for skilled labour, fostering economic growth and reducing unemployment, particularly in rural and underprivileged areas. Vocational training enhances employability, promotes entrepreneurship, and contributes to the nation's socio-economic development.



Our Vocational Training Centre at Muni Seva Ashram Goraj, established in 2011 through a Public-Private-Partnership with the Development Support Agency of Gujarat (D-SAG), exemplifies this mission. The center focuses on empowering tribal youth and women by providing employable technical education. Over 80% of our admissions are female, supporting "Save Girl Child" and "Women Empowerment" initiatives. The campus offers spacious, hygienic accommodations with nutritious food and medical facilities, funded by government grants, sponsorships, and donations.



With state-of-the-art facilities, experienced faculty, and strong industry connections, we offer specialized courses in four growing sectors. These courses provide time efficiency and early income opportunities for families with limited means, keeping pace with evolving technology to ensure industry readiness. Our aim is to create a skilled workforce that drives innovation and productivity, ensuring a brighter future for our communities.

Vocational Training Centre From Training to Triumph

The centre promotes holistic development, ensuring education goes beyond grades. Our training provides well-paying job opportunities and prepares students for future challenges. Weekly internal exams assess progress, with session exams at the end of the first and second sessions. Students who fail must repeat the session. An external exam by NSQF/Skill India agencies is held during the third session, with a 100% pass rate among 297 students. Graduates who complete a 2-month internship receive certification and a start-up kit at the bi-monthly convocation.



Networking with local NGOs, dedicated school principals, and teachers is highly beneficial. Our team visits communities and schools in Dahod, Panchmahal, Tapi, and Narmada districts.

VTC and Rotary Club, in collaboration with Bosch Foundation and Nalanda Vidyalaya, have launched the BRIDGE Program. This three-month course aims to skill youth for India's service sector, offering soft skills, life skills, job training, and placement assistance.



Here is some wonderful news from our CNC operator course in the industrial sector. Seven of our students, including six remarkable young women, were recently interviewed and hired by Lauritz Knudsen (formerly L&T Switchgear), a prominent name in electrical and automation. They have all been offered impressive starting salaries at the Vadodara Switchgear Works (VSW), marking a significant milestone in their professional journeys.



Vina Rathva, a young woman from tribal village of Gujarat, dared to defy tradition by choosing a non-traditional vocational course of fitter / fabricator. Despite opposition, she stood firm, inspiring others to follow. Her determination led to a successful job at Aditya Birla, becoming a star employee and earning recognition for her exceptional work making her a trailblazer and a shining example of empowerment.

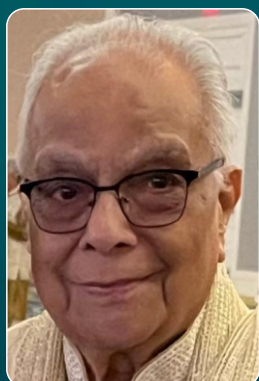
