We inaugurated India's first Omni Legend digiPET, a breakthrough in imaging technology. It delivers high-resolution images with improved efficiency, offering 40% less radiation and faster scan times. This enhances patient comfort and throughput, while improving oncology, cardiac, and neuro imaging for accurate diagnoses and monitoring.



We unveiled the GE Discovery RT Gen 3 for radiotherapy planning, offering the largest field of view and advanced 4D scan capabilities. This machine allows high-quality simulations for overweight patients, specialized setups for breast cancer patients, and precise respiratory gating with minimal prep. Its artifact reduction ensures accurate dose calculations,

aligning with our mission to provide top-tier compassionate cancer care, honoring our founder Pujya Shree Anuben's vision.

Kailash Cancer Hospital welcomed 60 first-year physiotherapy students from Parul University for an educational tour. They explored our advanced treatments and the role of physiotherapy in cancer care, gaining valuable insights into compassionate healthcare.



Kailash Cancer Hospital received the Outstanding Contribution Award at the Healthcare Owners' Conclave, part of MED in India, Ahmedabad. Also, our chairman, Dr. Vikram Patel, spoke on "Future Trends in Healthcare" during the event.

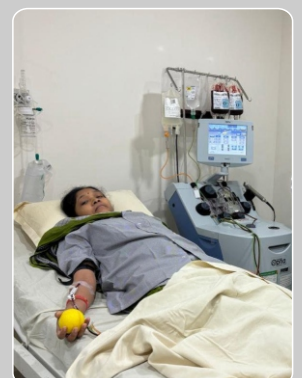

Sacred Cows, Sacred Bonds: Muni Seva Ashram's Journey to Harmony & Sustainability

Pujya Shree Ben's heart beats for the Gaushala. Her steadfast commitment to protecting cows from slaughterhouses resonates deeply with the wisdom of Dr. Vikram Patel, who reminds us that even beyond their milk-producing years, these gentle beings generate substantial income through the priceless gifts of Gaumutra and cow dung - nature's own fertilizers.

Today, Muni Seva Ashram's Gaushalas are sanctuaries for over 750 majestic Gir and Kankrej breed cows, graciously providing approximately 600 liters of life-giving milk daily. This bounty nourishes the Ashram's community and its various endeavors. The surplus milk is transformed into golden Ghee, crafted with love using the traditional Deshi Biloni method.

Ghee is available for purchase in 500ml and 1L vessels, and also offered in smaller quantities for those seeking its medicinal virtues. As we tend to the needs of others, we honor the timeless wisdom of Pujya Shree Ben: that compassion, selflessness, and harmony with nature forge the path to a brighter, more enlightened world.

Muni Seva Ashram's selfless journey has been a testament to the power of compassion and adaptability. As the needs of society evolved, the Ashram expanded its reach, guided by the visionary leadership of Pujya Shree Ben. The humble beginnings of kindergartens soon revealed a deeper necessity - nourishment for the children. Thus, our Gaushala was born, providing sustenance and fostering a sacred bond between humans and animals.

As the Gaushala flourished, the quest for self-sufficiency led to the cultivation of fodder, which organically blossomed into lush gardens of fresh vegetables and vibrant organic farms. This harmonious ecosystem became a shining exemplar of cow-based agriculture, challenging the notion that these noble creatures hold value only for their milk.

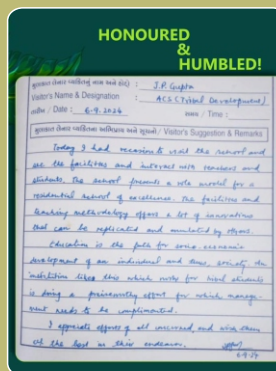


With every Rakhi tied, we strengthen the fabric of trust and affection.

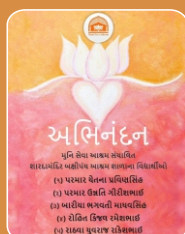

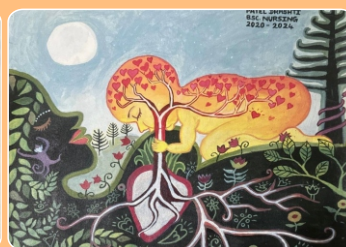




Independence Day Celebration

Tackling Rural Waste: Muni Seva Ashram's Sustainable Initiative

Indiscriminate market-driven growth and consumerism have resulted in unmanageable waste generation, a problem now affecting even Indian villages, especially those near cities. With Gram Panchayats bearing the burden of waste management, the consequences include severe pollution, health risks, and environmental degradation. Villages around Muni Seva Ashram face these challenges, and the Ashram has responded by implementing a sustainable waste management system, setting a model for surrounding communities.

Implementation Strategy:

Partnership: Collaborating with the NGO "Kachare se Azadi" to raise awareness and involve the community in waste segregation and composting efforts.

Infrastructure: Establishing a modern waste management facility using dry fermentation technology for biogas production from unsegregated waste and converting plastic and agro-waste into fuel pellets.

Biogas & Compost: Biogas will power the system, and the slurry will be utilized as organic fertilizer, promoting a circular economy.

Funding & Support:

Muni Seva Ashram seeks approximately ₹1.35 crores in CSR funding for the project's setup. Interested donors can review the detailed project plan. Revenue from biogas, organic fertilizer, recycled materials, and fuel pellets will ensure long-term sustainability.

Social Impact:

This project will create jobs, foster environmental stewardship, and serve as a replicable model for other villages. Muni Seva Ashram's commitment to purchasing biogas and compost ensures financial sustainability, while transforming waste into valuable resources for the community.
